- <sup>4</sup>From of old no one has heard or perceived by the ear, no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for him.


## Old Testament Reading: Isaiah 64:1-9

- hear our prayer.




#### The Words of Our Lord


body, which is given for you. This do in remembrance of Me."
